





Cooperation with organization "Mezi námi o.p.s."



The time is not easy and we hear from all sides the call to reduce social contacts in society. The most vulnerable group are the elderly, living in nursing homes, who cannot meet their grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

The EduArt kindergarten considers the idea of connecting the oldest with the youngest to be very important, and therefore we cooperate with the organization Mezi námi o.p.s. Children in Prague 4 are involved in the "Talk" program and regularly visit the nearby Alzheimer's Home in Modřany. Here, together with their grandmothers and grandfathers, they create, sing, play various games in the area of the home for the elderly and enjoy the time spent together. Another joint program is called "Read", during which grandmother Dagmar visits our kindergarten and reads fairy tales to children. Young and old discover, get to know each other, learn about mutual respect and esteem. Children pass on energy and vitality to grandmothers and grandfathers. A warm relationship is established between children and seniors.



Organization Mezi námi o.p.s. supports the meeting of people of all generations. Nowadays, communication takes place at least thanks to the delivery of small gifts at a distance and the connection through the coordinator. When we are sure that we cannot infect and endanger each other in the current pandemic situation, everything will return to normal.
