Dear parents,

Thank you for taking the time to read our regular monthly newsletter. In this editorial, I will focus on the school education program (SEP), whose preparations for the new school year are currently at their peak. Our teachers are already planning topics from September 2024, and we will present the results of their work to you in June via our application.

The school curriculum is a basic document that determines the main principles and structure of education in EduArt. It serves as a pedagogical support for teachers and as a transparent guide for parents, through which they can better understand our concept, methods and, more specifically, what activities await their children during the year.



Our school combines modern educational methods with an emphasis on the individual needs of each child. The program, which is fully in line with the Framework Educational Program of the Ministry of Education and Culture of the Czech Republic, provides a clear overview of the pedagogical direction of the kindergarten. It is divided into sections focused on the development of children from the youngest age groups. It includes activities such as drama education, movement education, environmental education, English teaching, and the application of Gardner's theory of multiple intelligences, which allows children to develop their abilities in accordance with their natural inclinations and talents. We support play, creativity and curiosity, which are key to a child's all-round development.

An integral pillar of the program is cooperation between the school and parents, which is essential for the harmonious development of one's children. Part of the partnership with parents are regular consultations and the opportunity to participate in school events and seminars, which enable parents to actively participate in the events at the kindergarten.

The basic topics of the programs of all our branches are already known. Let me introduce you to them. In the **kindergarten in Prague 9**, the teachers are working on the topic Four Magical Rulers. Each ruler will take the children with Eda through the year and reveal to us the secrets of their seasons. The children will be able to enjoy, for example, the Lord of the Colorful Autumn or the magical winter. With the arrival of each ruler, the tree in each class will also change and bear the characteristic features of the given period.

The **Prague 2 branch** will focus on Edík's collection of songs and poems. Each theme will be accompanied by a new song or poem that will be in line with this theme. A kindergarten songbook and a collection of poems will be continuously created, with which the children will continuously work with and certainly be happy to return to.

In the **kindergarten in Prague 4**, the central motif is Edík and his magic key, which will gradually unlock the doors for the children throughout the year. The motivational object is a chest, which the children will always open with a key at the beginning of the week. The chest will change its appearance according to the season and its contents will change every week. At the beginning of each new week, the children will unlock the chest and discover clues and symbols related to the upcoming theme.
